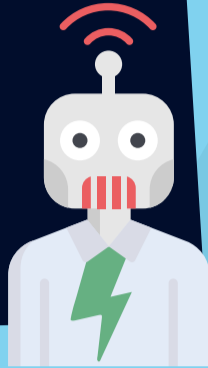


TOP 10 REASONS WHY LAWYERS LOVE CONTRACT REVIEW AUTOMATION (CRA)
